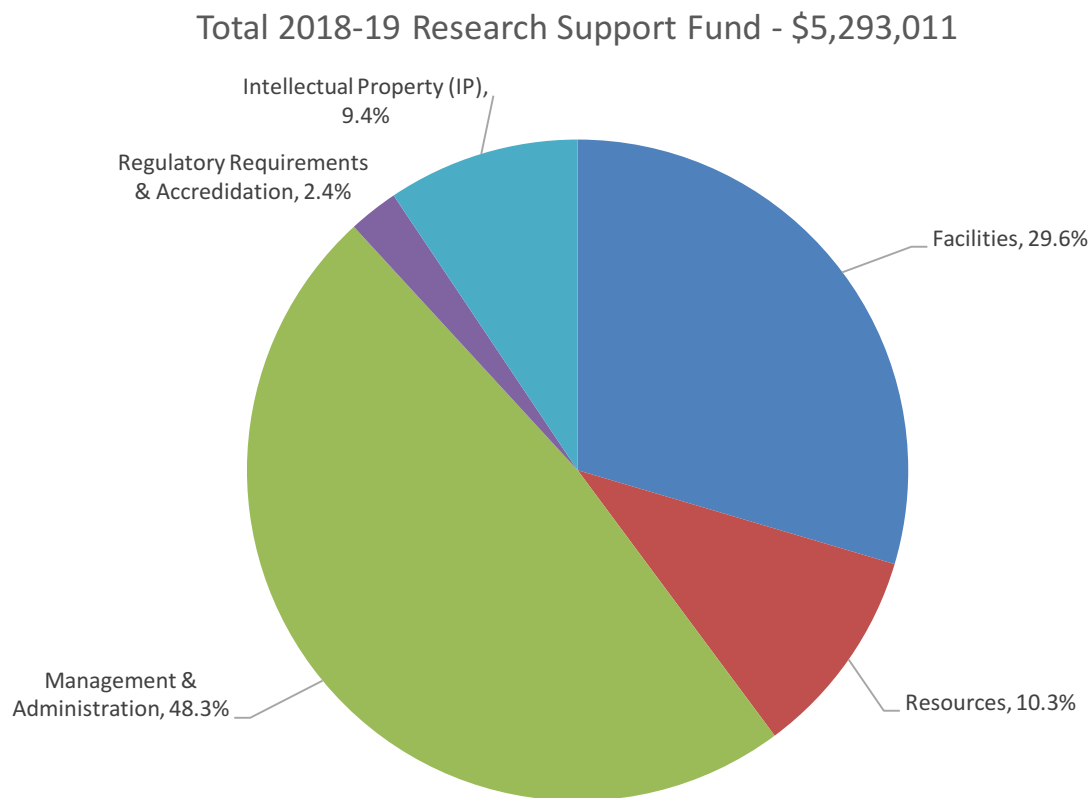


## Ryerson University
