## Project Description 1/3

Since not all Committee members will have an intimate knowledge of the subject matter of all proposals, the proposal must avoid jargon and highly technical content.

The project description must include:

**Objectives** — The specific nature of the SRC activity to be funded.

**Context** — A brief literature review to situate the project, its relevance and its potential contributions to the field.

**Methodology** — The methodology or theoretical approach to be employed, including data collection and analysis strategies.

**Timeline** — The time period within which the work will be undertaken.

**Key words** — Up to five project key words.





## **Knowledge Mobilization and Anticipated Outcomes 1/1**

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There should be a clear indication of the expected outcome(s) of the proposed SRC activity (e.g., publications, presentations, student training, preliminary stage of a large project, etc.), including how the proposed SRC activity will prepare the applicant for future externally funded applications where appropriate.
